Lufumbo Water Harvesting Project

In Butere, Kenya, at Lufumbo Primary School, Joining Hearts and Hands is currently constructing a 40,000 gallon water collection tank. The tank will collect rain water from

the roofs of two classroom blocks. Currently, Lufumbo does not have enough water for drinking, cooking or sanitation. This project will solve all of these problems.

Micro-Business on the Roll

The Income Generating Learning Activity at Iranda Primary School is well on its way. As you can see from the photo below, the first crops are ready for harvest. They are growing greens (sukumawiki) and tomatoes. Sukumawiki is much like collard greens. This project will feed local families through the sale of the crops. Also, students learn how to grow the vegetables.



Our dairy goat project is moving forward. All 40 community members have been trained extensively over the past several months. Members of the group called SHIEBU have toured other facilities and will begin construction of the goat housing units in the next two weeks. They will then plant crops for the goats and we will be ready to purchase 14 exotic goats. Exotic goats produce greater quantities of milk than local goats of the area.

As always, thank you very much for your continued support. Through your efforts, we are able to lift up the world's poor.

Mbaka Oromo Health Clinic

Yesterday, 600 students, faculty and community members received their 3rd dose of Hepatitis B vaccine. This entire community is now protected from this deadly disease. Joining Hearts and Hands is proud to have provided these three clinics to the Mbaka Oromo community.
